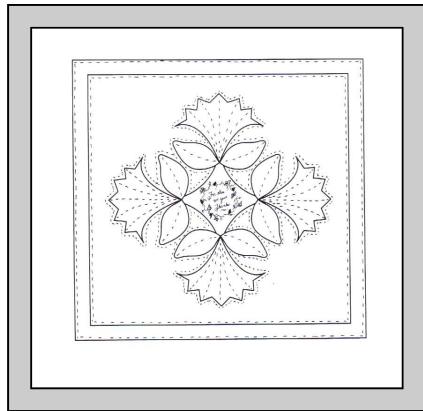




Sweet simplicity creates a cherished reminder of all that is good in this small wall hanging. Use a classic, two-color theme or use a variety of colors. Make two-one for a friend and one for keeps. (Remember to keep the center piece a light fabric for inking.)



Approximately 41" x 41"
(center block is 21" x 21")

Fabric Requirements

Yardage is for 42-1/2" fabric with 40" of usable fabric

- Center square—3/4 yard
- appliqué (all one color)—one fat quarter
- appliqué (various colors)—scraps
 - First border—1/4 yard
 - Second border—3/4 yard
 - Third border—1/3 yard
 - Binding—1/2 yard
 - Backing—1-1/2 yards
 - Batting—45" x 45"
- Fine—point permanent ink pen

Things to Know *Before you Begin*

All Quantities and cuts are based on 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics. All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance, unless stated differently in the directions. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Read through the instructions before beginning your project. All directions have been tested and are presented in good faith, but no warranty can be given nor results guaranteed. We truly hope you have fun with your project!

Cut:

- Background—cut one square 21-1/2" x 21-1/2"
- Appliqué—cut one of template A, four of template B, four of template C and four of template C reversed
- First border—cut two strips 2-1/2" x 21-1/2", and cut two strips 2-1/2" x 25-1/2"
- Second border—cut four strips 6-1/2" x WOF
- Third border—cut four strips 2-1/2" x WOF

Construction:

1. With a permanent ink pen trace the wreath and lettering in the center of piece A.
2. Follow the drawing and appliqué piece A, then piece B, and then pieces C in place. Center the design.
3. Sew the first border on the sides of the appliqué block. Trim ends as needed.
4. Sew the second border on the sides of the first border. Trim ends as needed.
5. Sew the third border on the sides of the second border. Trim ends as needed.
6. Load your quilt top and backing on to the machine frame.
7. Quilt, using your creative HQ imagination!
8. Bind, label and ENJOY!

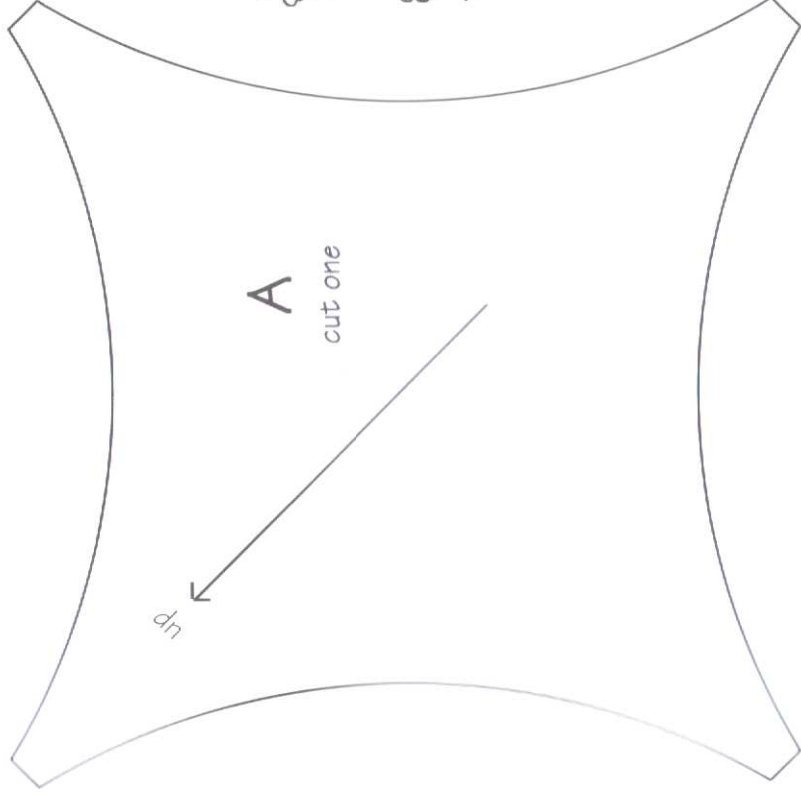
Make the Wall-hanging in your choice of color way & fabric type as directed.
